Questions:

- 1. Why did Samuel need to defend his leadership, ministry, and character in front of all of Israel?
- 2. What strategy did Samuel use in defending God in vs. 6-11?
- 3. Describe the cycle or pattern of Israel's behavior demonstrated time and time again throughout the Old Testament? Do you have a cycle or pattern in your own relationship with God? If so, compare and contrast it with Israel's.
 - Israel's cycle: forget and reject the Lord; God punishes and disciplines them; Israel cries out for help; God delivers Israel; Israel rejoices; Israel forgets God
- 4. What was Israel guilty of and how did Samuel make this clear?
- 5. In Samuel's closing argument in vs. 20-25, what stuck out to you the most that was most meaningful and why?
- 6. In this new arrangement and leadership structure, what were the conditions Samuel laid out in order for this to work? Why are these important today in our relationship with God?
