

Crafts:

Day One:

Supplies needed:

- Styrofoam cups
- Scissors
- Craft sticks
- Fish stickers
- Blue paper
- Cut outs of Jesus and John
- Crayons or markers
- Pipe cleaner
- Cut out of dove
- Tape or glue

Craft Directions:

- 1. Make "river water" by tracing the pattern on blue construction paper and cutting it out.
- 2. Add fish stickers if desired.
- 3. Tape the river water to the cup.
- 4. **Craft leaders: cut a small slit in the bottom of the cup. Carefully stick popsicle stick through the bottom of the cup.
- 5. Color a Jesus figure and a John figure (pre-printed) and cut out.
- 6. Attach the "Jesus" onto the popsicle stick. "John" to the inside of the cup. Tape or glue to attach.
- 7. Make a pipe cleaner with a dove figure. Attach the dove with tape.
- 8. Wrap the dove pipe cleaner to the pipe cleaner and reinforce with tape. Watch "Jesus" go down into the cup (water) and the dove come down from above.

Extra time = word search and coloring



Day Two:

Supplies:

- Scissors
- Popsicle sticks
- Cut out of Jesus and boat
- Crayons and markers
- Glue or tape

Extra time:

• Coloring page and word search

Craft directions:

- 1. Color the picture of the boat and Jesus.
- 2. Cut out around the picture.
- 3. **Craft leader: help cut on the line to create a slit for Jesus to "walk on the water".
- 4. Attach Jesus to the popsicle stick with tape or glue.



Day Three:

Supplies:

- Clothespins
- Scissors
- Printouts to cut and color
- Glue
- crayons/markers

Craft directions:

- 1. Color the tomb and rock. The rays at the top are sunbeams.
- 2. Glue the tomb to the back of the clothespin.
- 3. Glue the rock to the top of the clothespin (the part that moves up and down when you squeeze the clothespin.)

Extra time = cross and empty tomb coloring page





Day Four:

Wordless Gospel bracelets and Magnets and Scratch Crosses

Supplies:

- Crosses to scratch off
- Magnets
- Beads
- Pipe cleaners
- Crayons or markers

Wordless Gospel Rhyme:

My heart was dark with sin until the Savior came in. His precious blood I know has washed me white as snow. And in God's Word I'm told I'll walk the street of gold. To grow in Christ every day, I read my Bible and pray.

Craft directions:

- 1. First, talk the kids through the Gospel using the beads and the rhyme. Have them place the beads in order on the pipe cleaners to make bracelets. Have them turn to the kid next to them and practice saying what each bead means.
- 2. Give the kids the crosses to scratch a design into. Ideas: could write Jesus is the Son of God, Jesus loves Me, or a design.
- 3. Pack little white bags for the kids for their crosses, their bracelets if they don't want to wear them, the paper explaining the beads' meaning, and a magnet. Please also include an invitation card to our church. The kids can color the magnet if time allows. Write the kids' names on the outside of the bags for easy pick up at the end of the club.

Extra time: coloring pages or word search
