## Review of Genesis

- Four main themes unite the subplots of Genesis to one another while also connecting the larger book to the rest of the Torah, the Old Testament, and the Bible.
  - Eden (or “the land”)
  - Seed
  - Disharmony
  - God as Rescuer
- Genesis 1-3 establishes the redemptive pattern that will unfold throughout the rest of Scripture:
  - Blessing (1:28-30)
  - Rebellion (3:6)
  - Separation (3:12-19)
  - Provision (3:21)

## The Seed Outside of the Garden

- God’s Provision Through Seed (3:15-16)
- Two Seeds Formed (4-5)

<b>Cain (Gen. 4)</b>	<b>The Fall (Gen. 3)</b>
“What have you done?” (4:10)	“What is this you have done?” (3:13)
Cursed ground (4:11)	Cursed ground (3:17-18)
Driven from the land (4:14)	Driven from the land (3:24)

<b>Noah (Gen. 5)</b>	<b>Eden (Gen. 2-3)</b>
<i>Noah</i> sounds like <i>rest</i> (nuahk)	God rests (2:2-3)
Relief from the curse	Cursed ground (3:17-18)
Provision “out of the ground” (5:29)	Provision “out of the ground” (2:9)
