## **Review of Genesis**

- Four main themes unite the subplots of Genesis to one another while also connecting the larger book to the rest of the Torah, the Old Testament, and the Bible.
  - o Eden (or "the land")
  - o Seed
  - Disharmony
  - o God as Rescuer
- Genesis 1-3 establishes the redemptive pattern that will unfold throughout the rest of Scripture:
  - o Blessing (1:28-30)
  - o Rebellion (3:6)
  - o Separation (3:12-19)
  - o Provision (3:21)
