## **Questions:**

- 1. In what ways is it true that our culture's social axiom is "Image is everything"? How is this displayed?
- 2. As noted in the sermon, "seeing" is a major theme in 1 Samuel 16 (the Hebrew root word occurring 7 different times). Looking at vs. 7, how might you fall into seeing/valuing based on external appearance rather than the internal/heart? Or to word it differently, in what specific ways do you prioritize your external image over the internal (developing your character, deepening your maturity, and guarding your heart for it is the wellspring of life)?
- 3. Why is it so challenging for your personally to prioritize your "inward person" more than the outward?
- 4. Assign each person or couple in the group one of the following passages and spend a few minutes answering the question, "What does this passage say about how we should think about the external vs. the internal?" Then, come back as a group and share your insight.

- 5. Why is it important (or what are the implications) to understand vs. 7 as "God choosing David according to His heart/will" rather than God choosing David because of gualities David possessed?
