Questions:

- 1. When you think about the story of David and Goliath, what are some "knee-jerk" responses to what that story is all about?
- 2. 1 Samael 17:1-39 seems to be making three comparisons: Goliath and David, the Israelite army and David, and Saul and David. What do you make of this? What do you think the author is trying to do?
- 3. Why is it important to remember 1 Samuel 16:7 in this passage? How might this apply to the "three giants" (Goliath, Eliab, and Saul) David faces in this chapter?
- 4. Which of the three truths about God in vs. 36-37 is most meaningful to you right now and why?
