Questions:

- 1. What is being contrasted in 1 Samuel 18 and where in the text do you see this?
- 2. Why was it significant that Jonathan loved and was loyal to David? Why is it surprising?
- 3. How did Saul demonstrate his jealous hatred for David in this chapter?
- 4. What is the contributing factor to the favor and success of David? What does this say about God's presence in our own lives?
- 5. Discuss the negative progression of Saul's sentiment toward David starting in 1 Samuel 16:21 through chapter 18. What role did envy and jealousy play in this?
- 6. Assign each person or couple in the group one of the following passages and the challenge of discerning what the passage is saying about envy. Then, after about 5 minutes bring the group back together and go around and share your insight.

 - Proverbs 14:30
 - ➢ James 3:14-16
 - Galatians 5:19-21
 - ➤ 1 Corinthians 13:4
 - > 1Timothy 6:4
