Four Ways of Escape

I. David's Best Friend: vs. 1-7

"Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain?² The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and against his Anointed...Now therefore, O kings, be wise; be warned, O rulers of the earth.¹¹ Serve the Lord with fear, and rejoice with trembling.¹² Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and you perish in the way, for his wrath is quickly kindled. Blessed are all who take refuge in him." – Psalm 2:1-2; 8-10
