Questions:

- 1. Share a time in your life when you felt like you hit rock bottom. What was the hardest part about that particular experience?
- 2. How does chapter 30 provide one last great contrast between King Saul and David?
 - Hint: 1 Samuel 28:15 and 30:6
- 3. What does it look like practically to view distress as a gift? How did David do that in this chapter?
- 4. Spend some time in your group looking at various passages that talk about being strengthened by God. Split up into two groups, and spend about 10-15 minutes looking at the following passages (have one group take the first 4 passages and the other group take the last 4 passages). Then, come back and share what you've learned about what it means to be strengthened by the Lord.
