## Questions:

1. (Warm-up) What are things you adorn in your life and how?
2. Why is sound doctrine so important for God's people as it relates to the challenge of adorning the gospel?
  - Notice three different times (vs. 5, 8, and 10) Paul shows how our behavior impacts the watching world's impression on the Christian faith.
3. As you reflect on the specific instructions to adorn the gospel in vs. 2-10, find your age and share what was most challenging and why?
  - Older men: vs. 2
  - Older women: vs. 3-4a
  - Younger women: vs. 4b-5
  - Younger men: vs. 6-8
  - Bondservants/employees: vs. 9-10
4. What are other ways you can specifically make the gospel more compelling and attractive to others? What are some of the most common barriers to this?
5. As you think about application, what does discipleship look like in your own life?
  - Pastor Chris mentioned the "ladder of discipleship" and making sure you have an "Apostle Paul" or someone pouring into you and having a "Titus" or someone you are pouring into. What does this look like in your life?
6. How does your perspective need to change as it relates to the mundane and ordinary moments and relationships as it pertains to adorning the gospel?
